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**ELIGIBLE  
APPLICANTS:**

Must be second, third or fourth year evening/day Black woman law student enrolled in law school in the State of Maryland in good academic standing. In addition, students must be paid members of the Alliance of Black Women Attorneys for 2010-2011. **The membership application can be sent in with your scholarship application. You can also send a check for your membership dues with the scholarship application or you can pay your dues on-line. **CRITERIA:**

Scholarships will be awarded to applicants who demonstrate one or a combination of criteria, including academic achievement, leadership and strong commitment to the profession and her community. Financial need will be considered in awarding scholarships but is not a prerequisite. A strong candidate will highlight her involvement in programs that affect and promote the advancement of Black women in the profession and the community, as well as her ability to lead.

**AMOUNT OF AWARD:**

The Committee will award a scholarship in the amount of \$150 to a student from the University of Maryland School of Law or the University of Baltimore School of Law.
